



Suspensions Naming United States Federal Buildings

FLOOR SITUATION

The following bills are being considered on the floor under suspension of the rules and will require a two-thirds majority vote for passage.

These bills are expected to be considered on the floor on February 12, 2008.

SUMMARY

H.R.3468 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1704 Weeksville Road, Elizabeth City, North Carolina, as the "Dr. Clifford Bell Jones, Sr. Post Office." This legislation was introduced by Representative G.K. Butterfield (D-NC) on August 4, 2007, and was ordered to be reported by voice vote from the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform on December 12, 2007.

H.R. 3532 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 5815 McLeod Street in Lula, Georgia, as the "Private Johnathon Millican Lula Post Office". This legislation was introduced by Representative Nathan Deal (R-GA) on September 14, 2007. The bill was ordered to be reported by voice vote from the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform on January 29, 2008.

H.R. 4203 designates the United States Postal Service located at 3035 Stone Mountain Street in Lithonia, Georgia, as the "Jamaal RaShard Addison Post Office Building". This legislation was introduced by Representative Henry Johnson (D-GA) on November 15, 2007. The bill was ordered to be reported by voice vote from the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform on January 29, 2008.

H.R. 4140 designates the United States Postal Service located at 201 West Greenway Street in Derby, Kansas, as the "Sergeant Jamie O. Maugans Post Office Building". This legislation was introduced by Representative Todd Tiahrt (R-KS) on January 23, 2008. The bill was ordered to be reported by voice vote from the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform on January 29, 2008.
