

## **MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS**

Mrs. McMorris Rodgers of Washington moves to recommit the bill H.R. 4847 to the Committee on Science and Technology with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

Page 5, line 16, after the em dash, insert “(1)”.

Page 5, line 23, strike “otherwise” and insert “otherwise, so long as the State or local government in which such fire service training program operates provides that any firefighter or rescue personnel, entity, or organization, including a governmental or intergovernmental entity, providing inspection services or advice on a voluntary basis without expectation of compensation regarding proper installation, use, defects, or recalls of infant and child safety seats shall not be liable for any act or omission in connection with providing such services or advice that results in harm to an infant or child”.

Page 7, after line 6, insert the following new paragraph:

1       (2) That portion of paragraph (1) added by the  
2 amendment made by this subsection that appears after

1 “otherwise” shall take effect after the end of the 2-year  
2 period beginning on the date of enactment of this Act.
