



Suspensions Naming United States Federal Buildings

FLOOR SITUATION

The following bills are being considered on the floor under suspension of the rules and will require a two-thirds majority vote for passage.

These bills are expected to be considered on the floor on June 3, 2008.

SUMMARY

H.R. 1734 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 630 Northeast Killingsworth Avenue in Portland, Oregon, as the "Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Post Office". This legislation was introduced by Representative Earl Blumenauer (D-OR) on March 28, 2007. The House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform ordered the bill to be reported by voice vote on April 9, 2008.

H.R. 5477 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 120 South Del Mar Avenue in San Gabriel, California, as the "Chi Mui Post Office Building". This legislation was introduced by Representative Adam Schiff (D-CA) on February 21, 2008. The House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform ordered the bill to be reported by voice vote on April 16, 2008.
