



Suspensions Naming United States Federal Buildings

FLOOR SITUATION

The following bills are being considered on the floor under suspension of the rules and will require a two-thirds majority vote for passage.

These bills are expected to be considered on the floor on June 4, 2008.

SUMMARY

H.R. 3712 designates the Federal building and United States courthouse located at 1716 Spielbusch Avenue in Toledo, Ohio, as the "James M. & Thomas W.L. Ashley Customs Building and United States Courthouse". This legislation was introduced by Representative Marcy Kaptur (D-OH) on October 1, 2007. The House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure ordered the bill to be reported, as amended, by voice vote on October 31, 2007.

H.R. 5599 designates the Federal building located at 4600 Silver Hill Road in Suitland, Maryland, as the "Thomas Jefferson Census Bureau Headquarters Building". This legislation was introduced by Representative Carolyn Maloney (D-NY) on March 21, 2008. The House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure ordered the bill to be reported by voice vote on May 15, 2008.
