

**MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS**

M\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 928 to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

At the end of the bill, add the following new section (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 **SEC. 9. ANNUAL INSPECTOR GENERAL PERFORMANCE RE-**  
2 **VIEWS OF FEDERAL PROGRAMS AND AGEN-**  
3 **CIES.**

4 (a) PRINCIPLE DUTY.—Section 4 of the Inspector  
5 General Act of 1978 (5 U.S.C. App.) is amended—

6 (1) by redesignating subsections (a), (b), (c),  
7 and (d) as subsections (b), (c), (d), and (e), respec-  
8 tively;

9 (2) by inserting before subsection (b) (as so re-  
10 designated) the following new subsection:

11 “(a) It shall be the principle duty and responsibility  
12 of each Inspector General, with respect to the establish-  
13 ment within which his Office is established, to review an-  
14 nually the operations, efficiency, and effectiveness of all  
15 Federal programs within such establishment and submit

1 to the Congress and the President not later than Sep-  
2 tember 1 of each year recommendations, accompanied by  
3 proposed legislation, on whether an abolishment, reorga-  
4 nization, consolidation, or transfer of existing Federal pro-  
5 grams and agencies is necessary—

6           “(1) to reduce Federal expenditures;

7           “(2) to increase efficiency of government oper-  
8 ations;

9           “(3) to eliminate overlap and duplication in  
10 Federal programs and offices;

11           “(4) to abolish agencies or programs that no  
12 longer serve an important governmental purpose;  
13 and

14           “(5) to identify reductions in amounts of discre-  
15 tionary budget authority or direct spending that can  
16 be dedicated to Federal deficit reduction.”; and

17           (3) in subsection (c)(1) (as so redesignated), by  
18 striking “(a)(1)” and inserting “(b)(1)”.

19       (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—The Inspector  
20 General Act of 1978 (5 U.S.C. App.) is further amend-  
21 ed—

22           (1) in section 8(d), by striking “section 4(d)”  
23 and inserting “section 4(e)”;

24           (2) in section 8D(k)(2)(A), by striking “section  
25 4(d)” and inserting “section 4(e)”.
