

MOTION TO RECOMMIT
OFFERED BY MRS. CAPITO OF WEST VIRGINIA

Mrs. Capito of West Virginia moves to recommit the bill H.R. 1851 to the Committee on Financial Services with instructions that the Committee report the same back forthwith with the following amendment:

Page 107, after line 9, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 19. ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENT.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Rental housing assistance under
3 section 8(o) of the United States Housing Act of 1937
4 may not be provided on behalf of any individual or house-
5 hold unless the individual provides, or, in the case of a
6 household, all adult members of the household provide,
7 valid personal identification in one of the following forms:

8 (1) SOCIAL SECURITY CARD WITH PHOTO IDEN-
9 TIFICATION CARD OR REAL ID ACT IDENTIFICA-
10 TION.—

11 (A) A social security card accompanied by
12 a photo identification card issued by the Fed-
13 eral Government or a State Government; or

1 (B) A driver's license or identification card
2 issued by a State in the case of a State that is
3 in compliance with title II of the REAL ID Act
4 of 2005 (title II of division B of Public Law
5 109-13; 49 U.S.C. 30301 note).

6 (2) PASSPORT.—A passport issued by the
7 United States or a foreign government.

8 (3) USCIS PHOTO IDENTIFICATION CARD.—A
9 photo identification card issued by the Secretary of
10 Homeland Security (acting through the Director of
11 the United States Citizenship and Immigration Serv-
12 ices).

13 (b) REGULATIONS.—The Secretary of Housing and
14 Urban Development shall, by regulation, require that each
15 public housing agency or other entity administering rental
16 housing assistance described in subsection (a) take such
17 actions as the Secretary considers necessary to ensure
18 compliance with the requirements of subsection (a).
