



SUSPENSION NAMING A UNITED STATES FEDERAL BUILDING

FLOOR SITUATION

The following bill is being considered on the floor under suspension of the rules and will require a two-thirds majority vote for passage.

H.R. 6847 is expected to be considered on the floor on September 23, 2008.

SUMMARY

H.R. 6847 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 801 Industrial Boulevard in Ellijay, Georgia, as the "First Lieutenant Noah Harris Ellijay Post Office Building". This legislation was introduced by Representative Nathan Deal (R-GA) on September 9, 2008. The resolution was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, but was never considered.
