



## **Suspensions Naming United States Federal Buildings**

### **FLOOR SITUATION**

The following bills are being considered on the floor under suspension of the rules and will require a two-thirds majority vote for passage.

These bills are expected to be considered on the floor on October 1, 2007.

### **SUMMARY**

H.R. 2276 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 203 North Main Street in Vassar, Michigan, as the "Corporal Christopher E. Eskelson Post Office Building". This legislation was introduced by Representative Dale Kildee (D-MI) on May 10, 2007 and was ordered to be reported by unanimous consent from the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform on September 20, 2007.

H.R. 3325 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 235 Mountain Road in Suffield, Connecticut, as the "Corporal Stephen R. Bixler Post Office". This legislation was introduced by Representative Joe Courtney (D-CT) on August 2, 2007 and was ordered to be reported by unanimous consent from the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform on September 20, 2007.

H.R. 3382 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 200 North William Street in Goldsboro, North Carolina, as the "Philip A. Baddour, Sr. Post Office". This legislation was introduced by Representative G.K. Butterfield (D-NC) on August 3, 2007 and was ordered to be reported by unanimous consent from the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform on September 20, 2007.

H.R. 3233 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at Highway 49 South in Piney Woods, Mississippi, as the "Laurence C. and Grace M. Jones Post Office Building". This legislation was introduced by Representative Chip Pickering (R-MS) on July 31, 2007 and was ordered to be reported by unanimous consent from the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform on September 20, 2007.

These bills have not been scored by the Congressional Budget Office (CBO).
