



**H.Res. 630 – Congratulating the Warner Robins Little League Baseball Team from Warner Robins, Georgia, on winning the 2007 Little League World Series Championship**

**Floor Situation**

H.Res. 630 is being considered on the floor under suspension of the rules and will require a two-thirds majority vote for passage. This legislation was introduced by Representative Jim Marshall (D-GA) on September 4, 2007. The bill was ordered to be reported by the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, by unanimous consent.

H.Res. 630 is expected to be considered by the House of Representatives on October 9, 2007.

**Summary**

H.Res. 630 congratulates the Warner Robins Little League Baseball Team from Warner Robins, Georgia, on winning the 2007 Little League World Series Championship.

H.Res. 630 also requests that the Clerk of the House transmit an enrolled copy of the resolution to the City of Warner Robins and each player, manager, and coach of the Warner Robins Little League Baseball Team.

**Background**

On Sunday, August 26, 2007, the Warner Robins Little League Baseball Team defeated the Tokyo Kitasuna Little League Team by a score of 3-2 to win the 2007 Little League World Series Championship at Williamsport, Pennsylvania.

This was the second straight year that a team from the State of Georgia has won the world title.

The Warner Robins Little League Team was led by Manager Mickey Lay, Coach Mike Smith, Team Mother Robin Smith, and President Roman Jones.
