About the Cover

Named after the 25th President of the United States William McKinley, a Republican from Ohio, Mt. McKinley is the highest peak in the United States, and the third highest in the world. It is located within the borders of Denali National Park and stands at a height of 20,182 feet. The first successful summit was completed in 1913.

William McKinley served in the House of Representatives for 11 years, until he was elected Governor of Ohio in 1891. He was twice elected President, in 1896 and again in 1900, and was assassinated in Buffalo, New York during the Pan-American Exposition in 1901.
