



S.J.Res. 7 - Providing for the reappointment of Roger W. Sant as a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution

Floor Situation

S.J.Res. 7 is being considered on the floor under suspension of the rules and will require a two-thirds majority vote for passage. This legislation was introduced by Senator Patrick Leahy (D-VT) on March 8, 2007. The bill was referred to the Committee on House Administration on August 1, 2007, but was not considered.

S.J.Res. 7 is expected to be considered on the floor on November 5, 2007.

Summary

S.J.Res. 7 reappoints Roger W. Sant to the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution for a term of six years effective October 25, 2007.

Background

Roger W. Sant was appointed to the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution in 2001.

Mr. Sant is the cofounder and chairman emeritus of the AES Corporation, a global energy company operating in 28 countries and 5 continents. He previously served as assistant administrator for energy conservation in the Federal Energy Administration during the Nixon and Ford Administration. In addition, Mr. Sant has chaired several boards including the World Wildlife Fund – U.S. (1994-2006) and the Board of the National Museum of Natural History (present).
